11.10 / Poster/Flyer Policy for University Grounds and Facilities

- a. Exterior or interior surfaces of buildings.
- b. Sidewalks; utility poles; trees; automobiles or other vehicles; sculpture or other outdoor artwork; entry, directional, informational, or tra c signs; pillars; and other similar surfaces.
- 5. In connection with authorized student election campaigns:
 - a. Candidates for election must follow SGA election policies regarding the placement and number of publicity items allowed and when campaigning may begin.
 - b. Student election campaign materials may be posted on departmental or college bulletin boards.
 - c. Student election campaign materials shall be removed within three days after the applicable student election.
 - d. Yard signs may be used for student election campaign materials associated with student elections.
- ×. Chalking of University facilities is not permitted.
- 7. Yard signs are not permitted except as provided for in paragraph 5.d. of this policy.
- Ø Paint shall not be applied to any surface on campus.
- 9. Posters hebitil@/when wet, might discolor the surface upon which they are mounted, shall not be permitted and if posted shall be removed by university employees. A Åne may be assessed against the organization placing or displaying the poster/Áyer for any repairs or clean-up charges associated with damage to facilities.
- 10. Posters/gysts shall not exceed 18'exr24'ontWit/be dated, and contain appropriate print and content for the University community. The organization placing or displaying
