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

By choos ng to affil ate w th II a Paterson Un vers ty, all student e bers of the Un vers ty are ex ected to u hold the standards of th s un ty For the ur oses of enforcing the ode, students are со defined as ersons who have acce ted an offer of ad ss on and who have a cont nu ng relat onsh w th the Un vers ty, nclud ng tak ng courses at the Un vers ty, both full-t e and art-t e, ursu ng undergraduate, graduate, rofess onal stud es, or cont nu ng educat on Persons who w thdraw after allegedly v olat ng the Student ode re a n subject to the ode and ts d sc l nary act on unt l the atter has reached a conclus on regardless f they have a cont nu ng th the exclus on of trad t onal w nter relat onsh w th the Un vers ty er breaks, any nd v dual who s not reg stered for classes at the or su t e of a re orted v olat on s v ewed as a non-student but s st ll subject

Harass ent – Intent onally or recklessly engag ng n behav ors wh ch are suffic ently severe, ervas ve and object vely offens ve so as to substant ally d sru t Un vers ty o erat ons or substant ally under ne another student's ab l ty to art c ate n eng Pro ot on of llegal act v ty – ct ons, behav or and/or co un cat on that causes others to v olate Federal, state or un c al laws

Reasonable erson standard – bel ef held, knowledge known or act on taken or not taken by an ord nary erson under s lar c rcu stances

Re ort ng Student – The student who has rov ded the nfor at on necessary to ssu ng an alleged v olat on

Res ond ng student – The student who s charged w th an alleged v olat on under the Student ode of onduct

Restorat ve ract ces – category of resolut on o t ons that offer an o ortun ty to learn about PU's co un ty ex ectat ons for nor ol cy v olat ons and correct d sru t ve behav ors for first t e v olat ons w thout ncurr ng sanct ons or a conduct record

Retal at on - ny act aga nst any nd v dual or grou of nd v duals nvolved n the re ort, nvest gat on and/or resolut on of an allegat on of a ol cy v olat on Retal at on can be co tted by any nd v dual or grou of nd v duals Retal atory conduct s roh b ted regardless of whether t occurs on or off ca us, n erson, or through soc al ed a, e- a l, or other for s of co un cat on

Substant ve d sru t on of the educat onal rocess – ct ons, behav or and/or co un cat on that causes obstruct on and/or s gn ficant nterference to the learn ng, research or teach ng env ron ent

True threat – ct ons, behav or and/or co un cat on that endangers or threatens to endanger the health, safety or welfare of another erson

### **Proscribed Conduct**

student or student organ zat on ay be accountable to both the Un vers ty and c v l author t es for acts that v olate the law as well as the Student ode of onduct Exce t n extraord nary c rcu stances, d sc l nary act on at the Un vers ty w ll roceed dur ng the end ng cr nal roceed ngs and w ll not be subject to challenge on the grounds that end ng cr nal charges nvolv ng the sa e nc dent have been ost oned, d s ssed, or reduced The Un vers ty reserves the r ght to a ly ts own standard and rocedure under th s ol cy and to reach ts own deter nat on on v olat ons of th s code unaffected by the standard, rocedure or outco e of any c v l or cr nal roceed ngs

Generally, v olat ons of rules and regulat ons n the res dence halls w ll be handled by the Office of Res dence L fe lleged ol cy v olat ons regard ng student organ zat ons w ll be adjud cated by the Office of

# The Appeal Process for Cases Addressed by the Uni ersity Hearing Board

The a eal rocess can only be le ented n cases where the outco e has resulted n Loss of a us Hous ng, Sus ens on or Ex uls on fro the Un vers ty The le entat on of sanct ons nvolv ng loss of ca us hous ng or class attendance ay be delayed only when the res ond ng student files an a eal regard ng loss or sus ens on of these r v leges These r v leges ay be re nstated end ng the conclus on of the a eal rocess

The res ond ng student has five ( bus ness days fro the date they were nfor ed of the Un vers ty Hear ng Board's dec s on to file a wr tten a eal to the V ce Pres dent of Student evelo ent The wr tten a eal ust be rece ved by 11: on the fifth bus ness day c t ng one or ore of the follow ng grounds for a eal:

If good cause ex sts, as deter ned by the rector of Student onduct and n consultat on w th a ror rate Un vers ty o rxx **w** t
