Jacksonville State University Board of Trustees Policy Related to Campus Use and Protection of Free Speech (As Required by Act 2019-396, Alabama Legislature)

PURPOSE

The campus grounds, properties and facilities of Jacksonville State University (hereinafter the "University" or "JSU") are devoted to and maintained for the

That students, administrators, faculty and staff are free to take positions on public controversies and matters of public concern and to engage in protected expressive activity in outdoor areas of the campus, and to spontaneously and contemporaneously assemble, speak, and distribute literature.

That the outdoor areas of a campus of the University shall be deemed to be a forum for members of the Campus Community.

That there shall be no designated "free speech zones" whereby expressive activity is restricted to such an area to the exclusion of the remainder of the campus. No such "free speech zones" shall be created within the outdoor areas of the campus in order to
