Written conduct records of students who have been expelled or who leave pending conduct matters may be maintained indefinitely.

The university for longitudinal records may retain conduct records in the computer information system indefinitely.

If a student is suspended or expelled from Plymouth State University, a student conduct withdrawal is noted on the student's official transcript. In the case of suspension, the student will be ineligible to register or attend classes at any University System of New Hampshire affiliate.
