To wit, I direct your attention to Robert Shibley's comment in his November 20, 2008 article, "Tennessee State Bans JuicyCampus.com from Network" which noted, "[S]tudents, faculty, and administrators need to come to terms with the fact that the Internet is changing how takes away some of the ability for people to determine the source of that information and whether or not it is true."
