

4. All aspects of the physical search of a room and its contents will be conducted by a Public Safety officer(s).

5. A staff member of the same sex as the residents in the room must be present (e.g. in an all female rooms a female Public Safety Officer or female Residence Life staff member must be present). Exceptions will be made depending on the severity of the criminal offense, the possibility of imminent danger, and/or the availability of other staff members.

6. In the event a criminal offense occurred and damage is incurred to personal property in the process of the search, neither Saint Xavier University nor the personnel performing the search will be liable.

Tornado Procedures – Notifications of tornado warnings for Saint Xavier University are received by local sirens and commercial radio and television. The Department of Public Safety will notify the Residence Life staff if a tornado warning has been issued. If a tornado warning has been issued, residents should seek protective shelter.

When you are informed of a tornado warning:

1. Unlock, but do not open, your windows to allow air-pressure stabilization.

- Refusing to allow qualified University personnel into a room for the purpose of health, fire, safety or maintenance duties; and
