Dear Michael,

I am writing this letter to you in your capacity as representative of the DePaul Conservative Alliance. This letter is to confirm our conversation from February 15, 2006. As discussed in that meeting, having completed the university investigation regarding the DePaul University Anti-Discriminatory Harassment complaint against DePaul Conservative Alliance (DCA) of January 17, 2006, the following are the findings.

- 1. DCA was not found in violation of the Anti-Discriminatory Harassment Policy.
- 2. DCA was found in violation of the Code of Student Responsibility: Student Organizations, Practices and Policies (pg. 29).

As a result of this violation the following sanctions have been applied:

1. University Censure (pg. 42)
 - a. DePaul Conservative Alliance (DCA) from January 17, 2006 through
2. Restriction: (pg. 42)
 - a. DCA will lose the "promotional tables" at DePaul University from January 17, 2006 through September 18, 2006.


3. Educational Projects: (pg. 42)

a. DCA will contact the Office of Student Life and participate in the next available student organization orientation session regarding student organization policies and procedures, to be completed no later than May 26, 2006.

b. Prior to May 26, 2006, DCA will participate in and/or host one or more educational events on campus. These events may be panel discussions, roundtables, discussion panels, debates, speeches or other educational opportunities.

however I am confident in your ability to adhere to these sanctions and to move forward
