a. DePaul Conservative Alliance (DCA) ~~privileges of utilizing~~ ~~from January 17, 2006 through September 18, 2006.~~


3. Educational Projects: (pg. 42)

a. DCA will contact the Office of Student Life and participate in the next scheduled student organization orientation, training regarding anti-discrimination policies and procedures, to be completed no later than May 26, 2006.
