On December 6, OSU students Nigel Pence and Ron Grayson Burns, with Pataky as their guest, began pamphleteering in the Ohio Union. These fliers promoted the OSU Young America's Foundation student group and protested OSU's apparent "green zone" policy. After about 30 minutes, as a video of the events shows, Gladish again intervened, arguing that OSU's "green zone" policy prohibited pamphleteering in the Union, and she again ordered that this expressive activity cease. Gladish cited the Union's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification as part of her argument. Gladish added that if she acknowledged the right to distribute fliers in the Union, she would have to grant this right to OSU's "1,000-plus" student organizations as well. Burns then asked Gladish to produce the apparent anti-pamphleteering policy. Gladish promised to do so, but she left and
